- 2. All boats must be operated in a manner so as to create "no wake." Wake is defined as the track of a boat moving through water.
- 3. Each boat must have a LGPOA decal affixed to the exterior starboard and port bow (front) in order to access the lake. Decals can be obtained from Chad Smith (President), via e-mail at chadd@lansingcamera.com
- 4. Dogs are not permitted in the parks at any time for any reason, leashed or unleashed.
- 5. Fishing is permitted, however, this is a "catch-and-release" lake. Our lake is a closed environment. While the Association may stock the lake from time to time, we are trying to create and environment where the fish will increase their numbers on their own. Please release the fish you catch so that others will have the same enjoyment.
- 6. Swimming across the lake is prohibited unless the swimmer is accompanied by a boat. This is a serious safety issue, as it is difficult for boat drivers to see swimmers in the middle of the lake.
- 7. Only Lake Geneva Property Owners Association members and their guests are permitted to use the parks and lake. If you believe a non-member is using the parks or lake, please ask to see their beach pass on contact the security personnel on site.
- 8. We appreciate your help in keeping the parks and lake clean. If you see trash, please pick it up and put it in a trash container. If there are weeds accumulating on the beach, please use one of the available rakes and rake it to the side.
- 9. Speeding has become a significant problem in the Association. Please observe all posted speed limits and encourage compliance within your neighborhood.
