# LGPOA – SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES

Wednesday, October 8, 2008

### 1. Call to Order / Roll Call at 7:55 pm.

### 2. Discussion about Chateau Shores:

One of the Chateau Shores subdivisions changed their Building and Use Restrictions to permit sheds. Dan asked the LGPOA attorney to take a look at this issue.

### 3. Fences:

There are a number of fences, old and new, that people are beginning to report to the Board. The Compliance Committee will address fences on an individual basis as complaints are received.

## 4. The Lake:

A discussion was held regarding the lake and the need to have an adequate reserve in place to use in the event of a catastrophic event regarding the lake. Lake Delton in the Wisconsin Dells area was pointed to as an example of such a catastrophe.

### 6. Dan Skorich:

After a discussion of both candidates, a motion to appoint Stu Shafer to fill the vacancy was made by Doug Earle and seconded by Chadd Smith, and the motion passed unanimously.
