Resolution Regarding Use of Boats on Lake Geneva by Guests

- 1. Guests of LGPOA members may use a boat on Lake Geneva only as follows:
 - A. Boats, include, but are not limited to, motor-powered boats, sailboats, kayaks, canoes, and paddle boards.
 - B. Boats shall be the only motorized vehicles permitted to operate on Lake Geneva. The operation of all other motorized vehicles on Lake Geneva shall be prohibited. Prohibited vehicles shall include, but not be limited to, Jet Skis, Personal Water Craft ("PWC"), Off the Road Vehicles ("ORV"), Snowmobiles, Quad Runners, and amphibious ATV.
 - C. All boats shall be operated in a manner so as to create "no wake." The operation of any boat in a manner that causes wake is prohibited. Wake is defined as the track of a boat moving through water that causes waves to break upon the shore.
 - D. The member's dues are current, and
 - 1) The member is present, or
 - 2) Upon request by Security or a member, the guest shall present a valid Park / Beach Pass, or
 - 3) The boat has an "LGPOA" boat sticker attached, and, upon request by Security or a member, the guest shall present a written note from the member granting permission and specifying the date of use, which is signed and currently dated by the member with the member's address and telephone number so that Security or any LGPOA member may verify permission.
 - E. Upon request by Security or a member, the guest shall provide their name, address, and telephone number along with valid photo identification.
 - F. The guest shall be subject to the LGPOA rules and regulations, and, a violation of such may result in the guest being required to leave.
 - G. The member giving the guest permission to use the LGPOA Parks assumes all liability for the actions of the guest.
